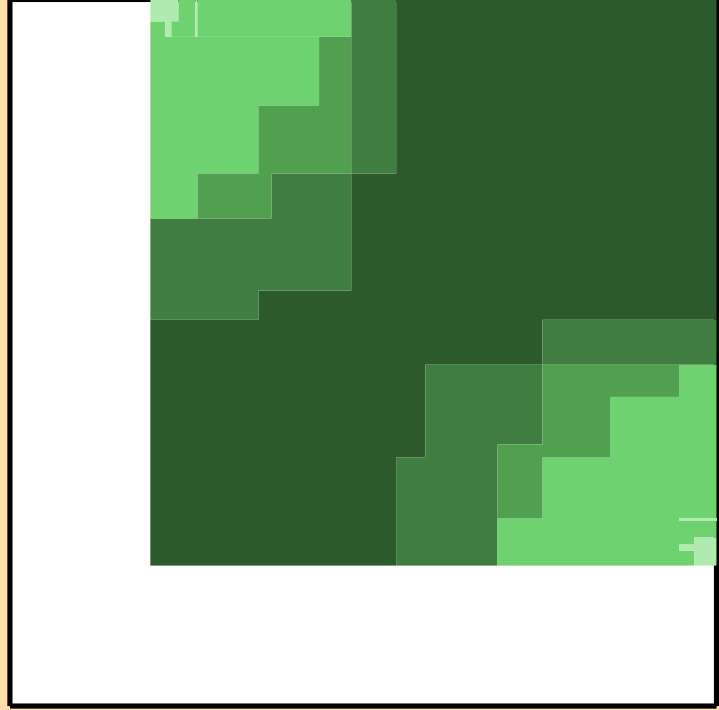
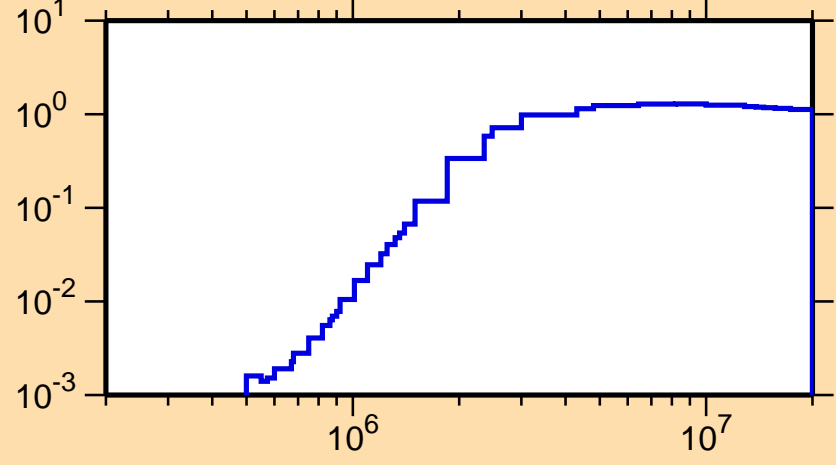
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{36}\text{Ar}(n,\text{nonel.})$

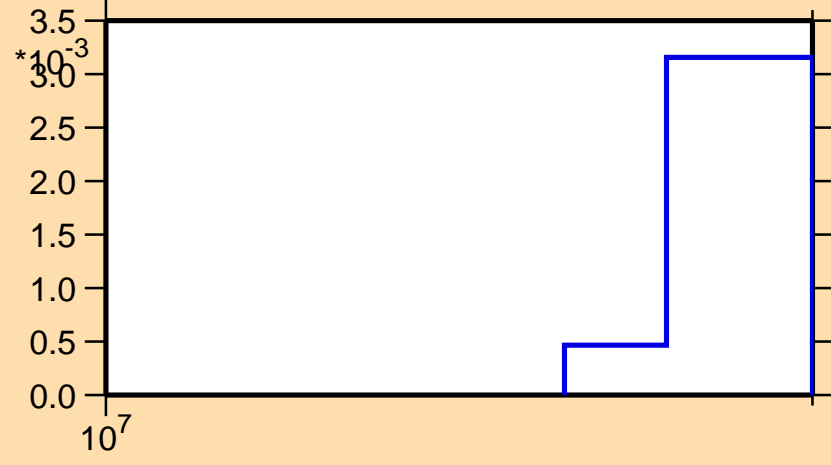
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{36}\text{Ar}(n,2n)$
