**WORKING GROUP ON INTERNATIONAL EVALUATION  
 COOPERATION**

The Chairman opened the meeting and welcomed the delegates to the first meeting of the Working Group, which had been established earlier the same day at the NEACRP meeting.

The Secretary was asked to collect and circulate a list of the members, including relevant information such as address, telephone number, telefax number and possible computer network addresses. The final membership list will be established by 31 December 1989 after the NEANDC has selected its permanent representation and the various projects have met to confirm their representation. The Secretary was also asked to prepare the final version of the NEANDC/NEACRP Task Force Report, presented at the NEACRP meeting, and circulate it to NEANDC, NEACRP and this Working Group along with the final Working Group membership list.

The procedure for starting sub-groups was discussed and it was concluded that each member of the Working Group responsible for a sub-group (called monitor) should, by 15th December 1989, after receiving additional input from the various project chairmen, make a list of people willing to participate in the work of the sub-group. These list should be circulated to the Working Group members for comment. Each monitor should then, by end of January 1990, have initiated the work of the sub-group, by choosing a coordinator and all members of the sub-group. Each sub-group thus formed, should write a 1 to 2 page document, before the end of March 1990, specifying in more detail how they would try to solve their task and within what time-scale. The document should be sent to the Secretary for further distribution to the Working Group members in time for the next meeting.

The procedure for initiating new tasks was discussed, following a question by A.B. Smith. It was concluded that proposals for new tasks would be welcomed from Working Group members and from other individuals. Proposals to be considered by the Working Group must be submitted through one of the evaluation project chairman. Proposals should be well defined and documented for discussion by the Working Group at one of their meetings. It was also felt that a document, informing scientists of the existence and mandate

of the Working Group should be written and circulated.

It was agreed that a copy of all important communication should be sent to the Secretary for filing. The Secretary would also help in circulating information to all members of the Working Group.

A status report from all evaluation projects should be presented at each meeting of the Working Group.

The next meeting of the Working Group would be held near Marseille, France, most probably just after the ANS Reactor Physics Meeting. The exact date and place will be communicated in beginning of November 1989.
