This CD contains scanned copies of all the Canadian Montreal Theory (MT) reports that I have found. There are some others, but they were never formally issued and are not available from any source known to me. In addition, I have included as many of the early British atomic energy reports produced under the auspices of the Ministry of Supply. The reader will also find the Volkoff lectures which provided the background for many of the early reactor physics calculations in the immediate post-war period in Britain and Canada.

A few reports from the Manhattan Project are included but only because I had these available. No effort has been made to track down all those reports with the prefixes CP-, A-, AECD-, AECU-, MDDC-, etc. I hope someone in the US will do that before the reports are lost to posterity.

I take no responsibility for the quality of reproduction on this CD. Many of the reports from which I made copies were in a very bad way and in some cases I have written on the manuscript what I think should be there, but I do not guarantee it.

This CD is being distributed free, for the purposes of scholarship. Beware that some of the reports, especially the Canadian ones, may have copyright restrictions. The British reports and the MT reports are available from the British Public Record Office where information regarding reproduction can be obtained.
