✓ TRANSPORT AND PARKING

✓ MÉTRO/BUS

- Line 10, Pont de Saint-Cloud station (less than 10 minutes by foot)
- Line 9, Pont de Sèvres station (15 minutes by foot)
- Future Grand Paris Express station
- Bus routes 169, 171, 179, 279, 291 – Pont de Sèvres bus stop
- Bus routes 52, 72, 126, 160, 175, 467 – Pont de Saint-Cloud bus stop

✓ TRAMWAY

- T2 – Saint Cloud station (15 minutes by foot)

✓ VÉLIB' & AUTOLIB'

Within 300 metres

✓ PARKING AREAS (CARS, MOTORCYCLES AND BICYCLES)

- Entrance at 46, quai Alphonse Le Gallo
- Approximately 580 parking spaces including 25 for electric vehicles
- Approximately 60 parking spaces for motorcycles and over 120 parking spaces for bicycles

✓ SECURITY

- Same OECD staff badges in Boulogne and La Muette
- Welcome Pavilion for delegates and visitors
- 24/7 site surveillance

✓ SERVICES AVAILABLE*

- Frequent shuttles between La Muette and Boulogne (intervals to be decided)
- Two communal areas per floor
- A restaurant, cafeteria and cocktail areas
- Medical pavilion
- A chemist, banks, retail shops and restaurants in the vicinity of the metro stations
- “Les Passages” shopping centre within 15 minutes walking distance
- Sports and well-being areas
- Société Générale ATM
- Room with sinks and microwaves

✓ OUR WORKING AREAS

- 30 000 m² of office space on six floors around a central courtyard
- A 4 000 m² amenities wing which will house the restaurant and conference areas
- Four large meeting rooms for around twenty people on each floor, together with numerous smaller rooms
- A conference centre** with a high-quality 200-seat auditorium, three meeting rooms capable of accommodating between 50 and 140 people with interpreters' booths, two meetings rooms for up to 40 people without interpreters' booths, and a reception area for 200 guests
- Teleconferencing facilities in meeting and conference rooms
- Training rooms

✓ A HIGH-QUALITY ENVIRONMENT THROUGHOUT

- All offices have natural lighting and all windows can be opened
- Landscaped areas help create a comfortable workplace
- Charging stations for electric vehicles
- Building rated as “outstanding” under environmental performance certification
